 - c) *Hronsek* (the articulated church, cemetery and bell-tower)
 - d) *Leštiny* (the articulated church and cemetery),
 - e) *Kežmarok* (the articulated church and building of *lyceum* in the buffer zone of the church),
 - f) *Bodružal* (St. Nicholas church and cemetery),
 - g) *Ladomirová* (St. Michael Archangel church and cemetery),
 - h) *Ruská Bystrá* (St. Nicholas church and cemetery).
